BREAD Library is primarily meant to allow students to take books home to enjoy reading away from school. So, please follow the detailed operating procedure for lending books to students.

Class teachers may select 2 responsible students, preferably girls, from each section. Together with

1. class leaders, they will be Voluntary Student Librarians (VSLs) to lend books to their classmates.
2. Library Teacher (LT) may train VSLs and class leaders to make entries in the Issue Register.
3. There is a separate Issue Register for each class and each page is for a student borrowing BREAD book.
4. VSLs will lend books to classmates during library period after making entries in the Issue Register (IR).
5. A student can borrow only one book. Another book can be borrowed on returning the earlier book.
6. Students may exchange books with schoolmates in vacation to read more books. They can return any book on reopening. Only student's name may be entered in IR and not name of book before vacation.
7. Prizes for best write-ups on library books will be awarded to two students from each class annually.
8. Students must use separate notebooks for write-ups and can take guidance from parents and siblings.
9. Students getting prizes once will not be eligible for prizes in the subsequent years.
10. At least 10 students must write reviews on 10 library books from each class to get prizes.
11. Class teachers, library teacher and HM will select the winners of best write-ups.
12. 5 write-ups of selected winners may be photocopied and sent to BREAD Library Group of Telegram App along with recommendation in the prescribed form by July/August of following year.
13. **Books & book-case must be collected by the school from Delivery Points as indicated at 13 above.**
14. **If the library is not put to regular use, it will be shifted to another school with donor's consent.**
